Head Start Disabilities/Mental Health Overview Sheet and Video for AzEIP Providers - Recruitment Purposes	Tami updated the committee on work that is being done by a committee of Head Start and AzEIP to help inform more of AzEIP's contractors to know more about HS. Currently working on making video for contractors to watch.  Tami informed on how AzEIP has some personnel changes, but is still asking for only severely delayed referrals not moderate.  Discussion started on rescreening. Re looking policies and tools used to screen infants and toddlers for referrals to AzEIP. FTF Summit is presenting data on how AzEIP/AHCCCS/Head Start over the last two years of working with committee to find where referrals should go, what the process is and how to fix it.  Concerns were raised about EHS programs not being able to reach their 10% SN enrollment due to sever delay mandate and difficult referral process for AzEIP.  Concerns and discussion about LEA's understanding roles and responsibilities for children that HS screens and then receives services. Services can delivered in HS and LEA isn't always the best fit.
