

How do I navigate the site?

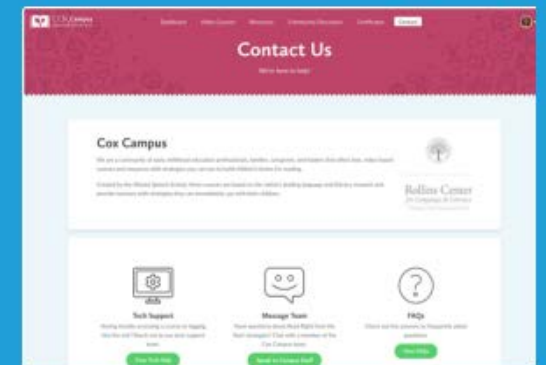

Upon completion of a video-based course on Cox Campus, you'll receive a certificate that shows your CEU is from an IACET accredited provider.



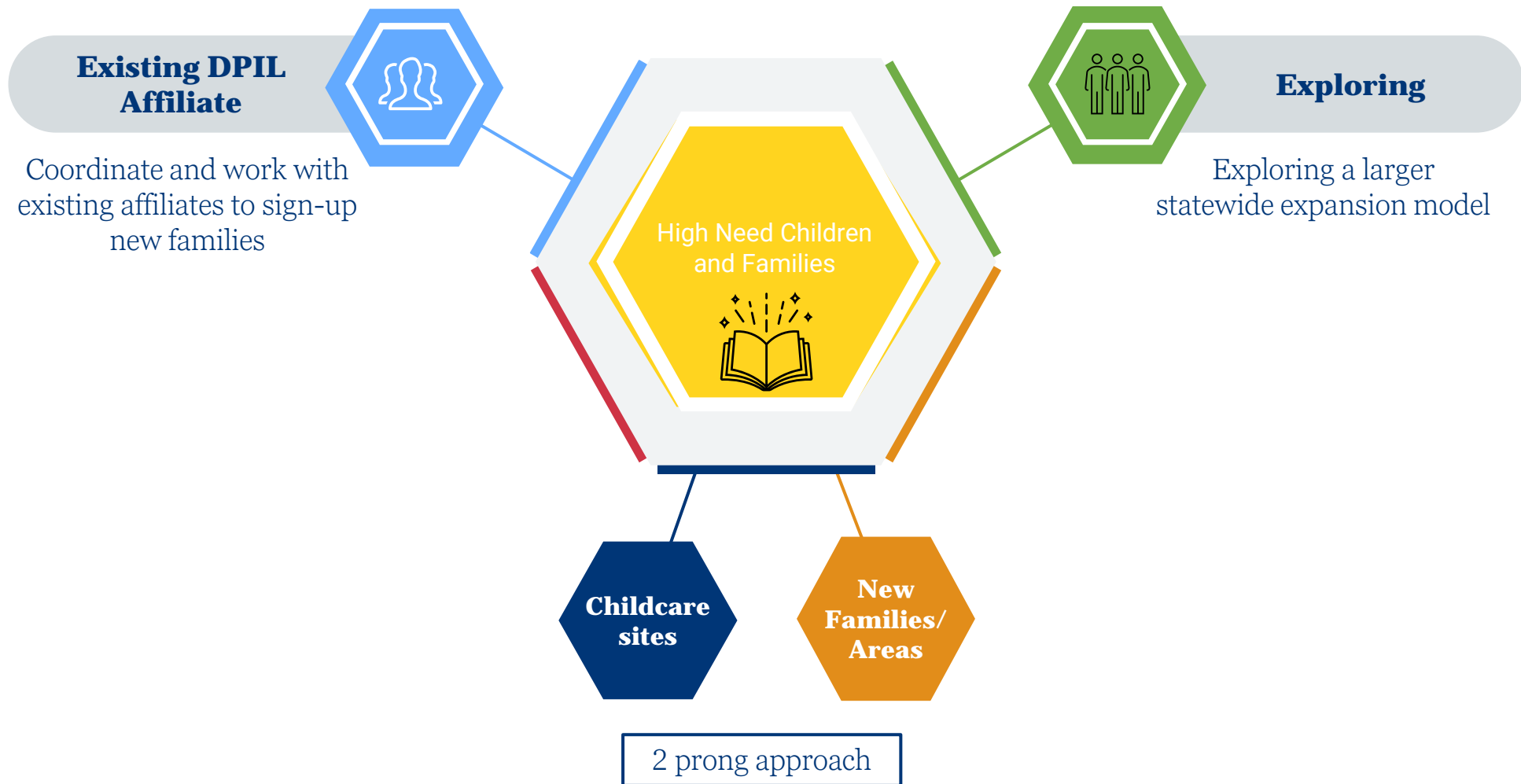
