## PARENT ADVOCACY GROUP

The Parent Advocacy Group has been implemented by AZHSA to train parents in advocacy and leadership. Parents are on a volunteer basis.

The Arizona Head Start Association (AZHSA) is Arizona's unified voice of Head Start programs serving children across the state.

Parents commit to a full year (Jan-Dec), meeting at least 1 time per month. At the moment, meetings are virtual but when possible, in person meetings and traveling may occur.

Parents learn about Arizona's state legislation, how to contact representatives and how to tell their story to support and advocate for Head Start.

Trainings are led by community partners who focus on leadership and advocacy. Parents will be able to use these skills to become leaders in their Head Start program and their community.
