# FY 2018 Budget ACF-PI-HS-18-03



- ► Includes an increase of \$610 million over the FY 2017 funding level.
- ▶ \$216 million provides grantees a 2.6% cost of living increase (COLA).
- ▶ \$260 million to support grantees increasing their hours of program operations.
- ➤ \$115 million for Early Head Start-Child Care Partnerships (EHS-CCP) and Early Head Start (EHS) Expansion, which includes a 2.6 percent COLA for existing EHS-CCP and EHS Expansion grantees.

### FY 2018 Cost of Living (COLA)



- ► Each grantee may apply for a COLA increase of 2.6 percent of the FY 2017 base funding level.
- ► COLA funds should be used to increase staff salaries and fringe and/or to pay for higher operating costs.
- ► Grantee proposing differential COLA increases to staff, delegates, or partners must justify its rationale in its budget narrative.
- ► Grantees will have to apply for the COLA through either a supplemental application or submitted as part of their FY 2018 application. **Applications due June 18, 2018.**

### Other Funding opportunities



- ► \$115 million for Early Head Start-Child Care Partnerships (EHS-CCP) and Early Head Start (EHS) Expansion
  - ✓ Provides for the 2.6 percent COLA for existing EHS-CCP and EHS Expansion grantees.
  - ✓ Funds round three of EHS CCP and EHS Expansion through a competitive application process.
- ▶ \$260 million to support duration of services.
  - ✓ Information on how to apply and criteria for applications will be released in a Program Instruction.

#### Other Funding opportunities



#### ► Program Improvement

- ✓ ACF-PI-HS-18-03 states "Grantees encountering program improvement needs should contact their Regional Office and submit supplemental applications throughout the year as needs emerge.
- ✓ Requests are addressed by priority and subject to availability of funds.

#### ▶ Training and Technical Assistance –

- ✓ OHS will make TTA adjustments for programs whose current TTA allocations fall below the floor funding for their program. (1.2% for HS TTA and 2.3% for EHS TTA)
- ✓ If a program is identified for additional TTA funds, your program will receive a funding guidance letter requesting an application.
