DES Child Care Administration Update	Lela Wendell CCA Administrator	<ul> <li>CCDF Plan is due this June</li> <li>The state plan development was focused on transparency, collaboration, reliability, and finding gaps and opportunities</li> <li>Childcare capacity and enrollment are down nearly 40% compared to pre-covid levels as of December 2020</li> <li>Funding received in Arizona in response to covid:         <ul> <li>a. CARES Act-\$88 million</li> <li>b. CRRSA Act-\$248 million</li> <li>c. ARPA- close to \$1 billion</li> </ul> </li> <li>AZECA has created subcommittees to make recommendations for the use of these funds</li> <li>Child Care Workforce Recruitment and Retention Grant Program opportunities are available</li> <li>Child Care for Returning Workers opportunities to launch June 1st for parents who are returning to work after receiving unemployment benefits</li> </ul>

State Legislative Update	Kelley Murphy AZECA	<ul> <li>2021 Early Childhood Priorities Include: Covid Relief for Providers, State Investment in Preschool, raise reimbursement rates, expand access to childcare assistance, improve quality, expand access to health care, supporting families</li> <li>Many bills supporting these items have died, but may receive support in federal relief funding package</li> <li>HB2016, Udall- signed 4/28/21 removes the 20-hour work requirement for full time students</li> <li>SB1011,Mesnard- signed 3/18/21 will establish maternal mental health study committee</li> </ul>
