

No. Unless a child has been evaluated and found eligible under IDEA, they do not count towards the 10% requirement. Clarissa asked Brenda this about a year and a half ago. Does not have this in written as they were written conversations. Clarissa will type up what she discussed with Brenda and share with Ana so they committee can follow up with Region 9. Lisa Adams/SWHD writes a 504 plan for each EHS child who qualifies for medically based services/private therapy. See the attached form. They count these children on PIR as having a 504
